This month we are also having our first workshop session at LDS on Wed. August 12, 7:30-9pm. You might attend to start on your first chart!

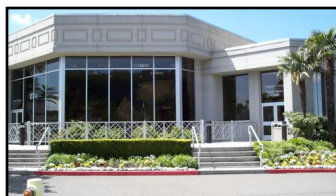
