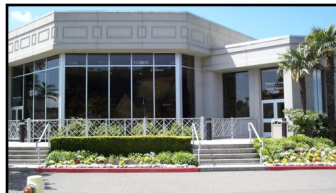
This month we will have a workshop session at LDS on Wed.
