Pat will be showing us some of the fine points of producing and customizing reports in Reunion. She has the following topics in her outline:

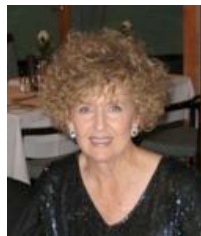
- Getting the Report you want

want to discover genealogy techniques on one of the best computing platforms and genealogy software programs in the business.

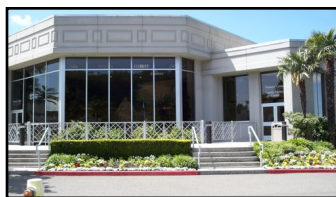

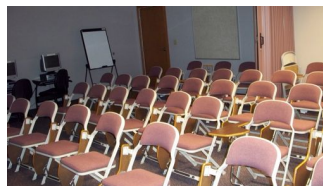
