Also, any questions about the Macintosh and genealogy are welcome. The Mac-only Reunion app, version 13 was released on October 20, 2020. They list 60 new features and have a top 10 features video. # Reunion Books



## *How do I make a book?*

See what content is available through Reunion, visually customized content you want, then design your front and back covers.

A book is an automatically generated yet fully customizable PDF document that you can share, publish, or print. It's based on several reports and includes several traditional book elements wrapped together into one cohesive and customizable PDF file for the 21st century.

The main elements of a book project include.

- Front cover
- Table of contents
- *Surname index*
- *Register or family history report (text optionally wrapped around pictures)*
- *Sources*
- *Media pages*
- *Place index*
- *Person index*
- Back cover
- Custom pages that you create, such as PDF files, RTF file, image files, etc.

## Reunion's Content

The **register and family history** reports begin with a person and include descendants up to a specified number of generations. Register uses NEHGS (Source is 1, children 2,3,4...), Family History uses Legal numbering system

The **ancestor** report begins with a person and includes ancestors up to a specified number of generations.

The **hourglass** report has the option to include descendants and ancestors. If descendants are included, that section of the report is identical to a **register** report. If ancestors are included, that section is identical to an **ancestor** report.

The **relative** report includes relatives in different chapters, and those chapters are based on relationships to a starting person.
